3. **CLUB VISION, GOALS**

- Kids Club – Andy will start setting this up with the local school over the winter, in preparation for next season

- Midweek league – We will be in the Reading Midweek League next season (probably Div 2)
- Recruitment – All members encouraged to try to recruit new players for next season.
- Courses – There will be Umpire and Scorer courses available. We'll try to enlist at least 6 WSL players. There is a possibility that next season bonus points may be awarded even if the Umpire or Scorer is playing (if they are qualified). TBD at the league AGM.

4. **2022 SUBSCRIPTIONS AND MATCH FEES**

WSLCC operates two different fees to help fund the maintenance and development of the cricketing and related facilities at the club:

- Membership Fees – these are paid in advance of the season, giving the player priority in selection decisions over non-members and a reduction in:
- Match Fees – these are the fees paid for each match day that a player takes part in

### **Platinum Membership**

To encourage Platinum membership, instalments are available for this membership type only, all other memberships must be paid in full. For those wishing to pay Platinum by instalments, the payment schedule is as follows:

- £50 by January 15<sup>th</sup>
- £50 by February 15<sup>th</sup>
- £50 by March 15<sup>th</sup>
- £50 by April 15<sup>th</sup>

Until all four instalments have been paid, the member will be subject to either Non-Member or Gold Member match fees depending on how many instalments have been paid.

Platinum membership also includes two free tickets to the WSLCC Annual Gig.

### **Sundays & Friendlies**

Sundays are invitation only games, are free for all Platinum members and will be subject to Saturday Member match fees for both Silver and Bronze members.

Friendlies will be subject to the pricing structure depending on when they are played e.g. a Saturday friendly will be subject to the Saturday match fees. The only exception will be that a game of 20 overs or less, regardless of when it is paid, will be subject to the midweek match fee.

### **Additional Points**

- First match for all new players to the club is free so they get to try the game and meet the players.
- There is no limit to the number of games that someone can play as a non-member, but non-member match fees must be paid for all games until membership fee is paid. Additional non-member fees paid cannot and will not under any circumstance be offset against subsequent membership fee paid.

- All match and membership fees above assume no teas are served at home games – if there is a change on this, fees will have to be altered accordingly. Indoor net fees are not included in any of the membership fees and charges made accordingly. Outdoor nets carry no fees for members who are paid up, there is a £5 charge for non-members and those yet to pay their membership fees.
- Students (those in full-time education with proof of enrolment) receive a 50% discount on match fees. Membership fees remain unchanged.
- For players experiencing hardship, a payment plan can be agreed to support the player. This can only be applied once we have been informed and will not be factored in arrears. The plan put in place will depend on individual circumstances.
- By applying for membership, you are agreeing to undertake ~~[a minimum of 10 hours]~~ work at the club throughout the season.
